## **Submission Guidelines**

The authors/contributors are requested to abide by the following guidelines while preparing and submitting their articles to the journal:

- a. The structure of the submitted manurscript should be in accordence with IMRaD format. Qualitative researches and reviewed papers must represent the latest update of the domain. In case of mixed method approach, the articles must rigorously follow any of the mixed method designs.
- b. The article should be preferably between 4000-8000 words in length. The article having more than 9000 words will not be processed;
- c. The article must be accompanied by an **abstract** with 150-200 words and 3-5 **keywords**;
- d. The body of article should be typed in 1.5 line spaced with Times New Roman, font 12;
- e. The manuscript should be submitted by e-mail as **Microsoft word** attachment;
- f. Use either British or American spelling throughout the text but **do not mix**;
- g. The author/s must attach a letter of declaration ensuring that this manerscript is not submitted anywhere else for publication, prescribed format of the declaration form is available in the journal web page;
- h. At the time of the submission the author has to be submitted a methodology indicating form, prescribed format is available in the journal web page;
- i. For referencing, the journal strictly conforms to APA (7<sup>th</sup>ed.) style.
