Submission Guidelines

The authors/contributors are requested to abide by the following guidelines while preparing and submitting their articles to the journal:

- a. The structure of the submitted manuscript should be in accordance with *IMRaD format*;
- b. In the last paragraph of the introductory section, please provide the purpose statement followed by research questions, hypothesis (for quantitative research), and research objectives.
- c. In the methodological section please mention the followed research design;
- d. The article should be preferably between 4000-8000 words in length. The article having more than 9000 words will not be processed;
- e. The article must be accompanied by an abstract with 150-200 words and 3-5 keywords;
- f. The body of article should be typed in 2 line spaced with Times New Roman, font 12;
- g. The manuscript should be submitted by e-mail as Microsoft word attachment;
- h. Use either British or American spelling throughout the text but do not mix;
- i. The author/s must attach a letter of declaration(*JSSRC: Form NO-A*) ensuring that this manuscript is not submitted anywhere else for publication;
- j. For referencing, the journal strictly conforms to *APA (7th ed.)* style.
